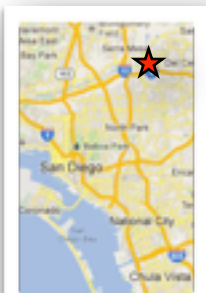

In the past five years InterVarsity Christian Fellowship has been at San Diego State University there have been:

- **Over 700 students involved**
- **140 leaders developed**
