These are just numbers, but behind each number is a life and



## Southwestern on Probation

Colleges and Universities are required to go through an accreditation to ensure the quality of the institution. This year Southwestern College underwent the accreditation process which evaluated education, administration, etc. Following the evaluation Southwestern College was placed on probation which means they have until October 2010 to
